

## *Continuation and New*



YAYASAN has been assisting the following Madrasah and Schools for years: -

- Ma'ahad Tahfiz Ashabissyahid, Tawau Sabah (90+ students)
- Madrasah Tahfiz Darul Zikri, Rawang Selangor (50+ students)
- Madrasah Tahfiz Darul Ulum Azzkia, Papar Sabah (20+ students)
- Sekolah Agama Rakyat Tuan Haji Muda Kg Bikang Lahad Datu Sabah (80+ students)
- Rohingya Education Garden, Puchong Selangor (80+ students)


### New Schools in 2022:

- Madrasah Al Hikmah, Likas Sabah (400+ students)
- Rumah Ngaji Pulau Kulapuan, Semporna Sabah (230+ students)
- Madrasah Sg Tekali, Hulu Langat Selangor (20+ students)

Scholarship is provided to students being offered a place to study in local Universities but unable to obtain financial assistance from another organisation. Currently, Yayasan is assisting 7 scholars in IMU, UiTM, UKM, UUM and UMK.

# RAMADHAN PROGRAMS

*Ramadan Food / Mosques, Schools and Families*



Donation drive was initiated almost yearly for Ramadan Food Program and this year, Yayasan managed to collect: -

**DONATION: RM41,890**

The fund was distributed to the following: -

- Iftar programs with Majlis Dakwah Sabah @ Masjids in Sabah with large mualaf community (RM11,000)
- Families @ Pulau Kulapuan Semporna Sabah through NGO Al Musta'an (RM8,485)
- Maahad Tahfiz Ashabissyahid (RM6,265)
- Rohingya School Puchong (RM5,000)
- Madrasah Al-Hikmah Likas (RM4,320)
- Persatuan Anak2 Yatim Ibu Tunggal Warga Miskin Lipis Pahang (RM2,420)
- Madrasah Tahfiz Darul Ulum AzzKia & nearby families (RM2,400)
- Tahfiz Darul Zikri Rawang (RM2,000)



## NEEDY FAMILY PROGRAMS

### *Poor Students & Families Assistance*



Yayasan contributes monthly to families for basic necessities which will help to ease their daily living hardships. More than 100 families have been assisted since 2005.

Twenty (25) families received monthly assistance and 10 received "one-off" contribution in 2022. Assistance also includes annual Back to School provision of school uniforms bags & stationaries to their children until they completed secondary school. Some of deserving children would receive scholarship for tertiary education.

Yayasan also visited the families and happy to note that majority of their living condition has improved with some of the ex-recipients' children earning good salary and helping them.

## OTHERS

### *Senior Citizens, Orphans and Underprivileged Girls*



Yayasan adopted 2 senior citizens homes in Kuala Perlis and Bangi, an orphanage in Ipoh and a home for socially challenging and underprivileged girls in Klang and has been assisting them for many years

- Rumah Wargamas Pertubuhan Kebajikan Penyayang Hani (8).







## Relief & Medical Assistance

## MEDICAL & RELIEF



- Currently, five (5) families receiving monthly assistance to take care of their relative/loved ones. Yayasan also gave “one-off” donation to buy medicine or equipment depending on the needs/request.
- Provided fund for Al-Musta'an to build Rumah Ngaji in Kulapuan Island, Semporna Sabah. Once completed and in operation, monthly contribution is given.
- Contributed fund to build the fencing for Surau Kg Tuaritaud Keningau and cemetery. The fund for surau came from individual's donation.
